## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Veggie Patch Panel - Cream (A), cut:

- (3) $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 421 / 2 "$ strips, piece as needed.

From the Bunny Toss - Cream (B), cut:

- (2) $41 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ strips, piece as needed.
- (3) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 481 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Mushrooms - Cream (C), cut:

- (1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares and
(2) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Spots - Brown (D), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

## From the Small Flowers - Cream (E), cut:

- (1) $4 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares and (4) $2 \frac{1}{2} "$ squares.

From the Square Patch - Blue (F), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (14) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Bunny Toss - Khaki (G), cut:
- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Small Flowers - Light Blue (H), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (14) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Spots - Cocoa (I), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Spots - Cream (J), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares and (2) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Mushrooms - Blue (K), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Mushrooms - Pink (L), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares and
(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Small Flower - Dark Blue (M), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
- (5) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Large Flower - Blue (N), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Large Flower - Green (O), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Large Flower - Pink ( P ), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Square Patch - Brown (Q), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Bunny Toss - Blue (R), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Square Patch - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 56 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $56 " \times 58 "$ back.


## Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.
2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2$ " Fabric D square to each of the remaining corners of the $41 / 2 "$ Fabric C square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make a second Unit 1 square.

5. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric L square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric H square, (1) $21 / 2$ " Fabric E square and (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric M square together as shown in Figure 9 to make (1) Unit 6 square. Repeat to make a second Unit 6 square.
6. Repeat Step 5 and use Figures 10-14 for

(1) Unit 6 Unit 1 square, (1) $4^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ Fabric $N$ square, (1) Unit 6 square, (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric P square, (1) Unit 2 square, (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric G square, (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric Q square, (1) Unit 8 square and (1) Unit 3 square together in that order to make (1) Block One strip (Fig. 15). Repeat to make a second Block One strip.
8. Sew (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric R, (1) Unit 4 square, (1) Unit 9 strip, (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric N square, (1) Unit 5 square, (1) $41 / 2 "$

Fabric G square, (1) Unit 10 square, (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric L square, (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric $F$ square and (1) Unit 11 square together in that order to make (1) Block Two strip (Fig. 16). Repeat to make a second Block Two strip.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)
9. Sew (1) Block One strip, (1) $81 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip, (1) Block Two strip, (1) $81 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip, (1) Block Two strip, (1) $81 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip and (1) Block One strip together lengthwise and in that order to make the Center Block. Pay attention to the strip orientations.
10. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric M strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
