

## **Etch Batiks**

Α		895Q-26 whisper	3/4	<ul> <li>(3) 2-3/4" x 33-1/2" width of fabric (WOF) strips.</li> <li>(4) 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (3) 2-3/4" x 56" strips.</li> <li>See instructions to cut (50) Stars.</li> </ul>
В		895Q-1 ruby	1-1/8	<ul> <li>(4) 2-3/4" x 33-1/2" WOF strips.</li> <li>(4) 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (3) 2-3/4" x 56" strips.</li> <li>(5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.</li> </ul>


### **Block Assembly:**

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

2. Press each Star template onto the wrong side of the fabric as listed on the template. Cut out

each Star template on the drawn lines.

- **3.** Refer to **Figure 1** to arrange and press the (50) **A** Stars onto the 23" x 16-1/4" **C** rectangle. *Note:* Dimension are to center of star.
- **4.** Finish the raw edges of each star with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the **Block One** rectangle **(Fig. 1)**.

- **5.** Sew together (4) 2-3/4" x 33-1/2" **B** strips and (3) 2-3/4" x 33-1/2" **A** strips, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make (1) 33-1/2" x 16-1/4" **Block Two** rectangle (**Fig. 2**).
- **6.** Sew together (3) 2-3/4" x 56" **A** strips and (3) 2-3/4" x 56" **B** strips, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make (1) 56" x 14" **Block Three** rectangle **(Fig. 3)**.




### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Refer to the Quilt Diagram while assembling the quilt top.)

7. Sew the **Block One** rectangle to the left side of the **Block Two** rectangle. Sew the **Block Three** rectangle to the bottom of the newly sewn block to make the quilt top.

#### **Finishing**

- 8. Layer and quilt as desired.
- **9.** Sew the (5) **B** 2-1/2"  $\times$  WOF strips together end-to-end with 45-degree seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- **10.** Bind as desired.
