Finished Quilt 57" x 66 1/2"

Finished Block 6 3/4" x 6 3/4"

Fabric Requirements

10" Square Precut - or 1/8 yard bundle

Joyful Journal

2 1/2 yards pink print - R311730D pink

3/4 yard light print - R311738D cream


1 yards tan print - R311725D tan

1/2 yard pink stripe - R311736D pink - binding

3 1/2 yards light print - R311731D cream - backing

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Patchwork Pages

Finished Quilt 57" x 66 1/2"

*Cutting instructions are written for two different options.
Choose which fabric option you are using and cut accordingly.*

Cutting | From 10" precuts

Pair up 10" squares by print and omit tulip light print, from each pair, cut:

61 squares, 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" | total 1159 squares

Cutting | From 1/8 yard bundle or scraps

From 19 prints, cut: 3 strips, 1 1/4" x 42" subcut 61 squares, 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" | total 1159 squares

From light print, cut:

20 strips, 1 1/4" x 42"

From pink print, cut:

10 strips, 1 1/4" x 42"

3 strips, 2 3/4" x 42" | subcut 32 squares, 2 3/4" x 2 3/4"

5 strips, 10 3/4" x 42" | subcut 14 squares, 10 3/4" x 10 3/4" | cut diagonally twice

1 strip 5 3/4" x 42" | subcut 6 squares, 5 3/4" x 5 3/4" | cut diagonally once

From tan floral cut:

6 strips, 5" x 42"


From pink stripe, cut:

7 strips, 2 1/4" x 42" | binding

Press all seam allowances as indicated by the arrows.

Making the Rail Fence Blocks

1. Make ten strip sets by joining one pink and two light $1\frac{1}{4}'' \times 42''$ strips along length of strip. Press seams toward pink. Subcut 128 segments, $2\frac{3}{4}'' \times 2\frac{3}{4}''$






Make 10 strip sets measuring,

Making the Nine Patch Blocks


1. Lay out five matching $1\frac{1}{4}''$ squares and four matching $1\frac{1}{4}''$ squares in rows of three. Sew the squares into three rows. Join the rows alternating seams at intersections to make a Nine Patch block measuring $2\frac{3}{4}''$ square, including seam allowances. Make 128 Nine Patch blocks.




Making the Patchwork Pages Blocks

1. Lay out four Nine Patch, four Rail Fence blocks and one pink square in rows of three.

2. Sew the units into three rows. Join the rows alternating seams at intersections to make a Patchwork Pages block measuring $7\frac{1}{4}$ " square, including seam allowances. Make 32 Patchwork Pages blocks.




2. Choose four Patchwork Pages blocks and draw a diagonal line (solid line) through the center of block. Cut diagonally $1/4$ " from drawn line (dashed line) Discard small piece.



Assembling the Quilt

1. Referring to quilt center assembly diagram, arrange blocks and pink setting triangles in vertical rows. Sew the pieces together diagonally in each row. Add the corner triangles to three rows last.
2. Join the rows lining up points of Patchwork Pages blocks.
3. Piece and add tan 5" strips to each side of quilt using your quilt center dimensions for length of strips. Repeat to add top and bottom border.
4. Quilt as desired and add pink stripe binding. Enjoy!
